**RE: ARKANA COLLEGE LIMITED -AND- THE ISLAMIC EGYPTIAN SOCIETY
DEED OF ACCESS**

1. We refer to our letter dated 22 March 2017 enclosing a deed which set out the terms upon which the Islamic Egyptian Society Incorporated (**the Society**) would be allowed access to the College's premises (**the Deed**). We note that a copy of the letter was also forwarded to the Society.
2. Our letter requested that the Deed be signed and returned to our office by Wednesday, 5 April 2017, failing which the Society's access to the College's premises would be restricted. The Deed has not been executed, nor have we received a response to our letter.
3. Please be advised that effectively immediately, the Society will be restricted from any further access to the College's premises. We are instructed that all security codes issues to the Society have been cancelled and we formally request the immediate return of all keys held by the Society. In the event that the Society requires access to College's storeroom or meeting rooms, this may be arranged on the condition that a representative of the College is also in attendance.
4. As previously noted, the College has responsibilities to its stakeholders, including the children in its care, their parents and teachers. In circumstances where the College
